

Parenting Study - New 4 Week Study has Begun! YOU ARE INVITED - Parents of all ages of Children

Willow UMC is offering a free parenting study for parents of children of all ages. The study, facilitated by Pastor Marianne, utilizes a parenting series by Jim Williams who is a national parenting advocate and speaker and the director of Parent Education and Asset Development for STARS, a school based program helping students make healthy lifestyle choices.

"Discipline With Children and Teens" will be the focus of the next 4 week study. The goal of this particular series is to help parents develop reasonable boundaries, limits, consequences for their children at each stage of childhood and teen development. The author focuses on empowering children to be responsible, accountable and dependable by the time they leave the parental home.

This class will meet on Sundays after Worship on June 9, 23 and July 7 from 11:00am to 12:00pm in the home of Laura and John Haydamacker who live about 2 minutes from the Willow UMC at 24340 Waltz Rd. New Boston. Jeanne Lochner, Children's Ministry Director, provides a Children's teaching time at the Haydamacker home during the study.

Is there ever a day that mattresses are not on sale? Why do people constantly return to the refrigerator with hopes that something new to eat will have materialized?


